We are doing our utmost here to inform and protect our sheep in Claremont. Amanda and her team made sanitizer from a recipe and distributed it among the 44 homes within the wall of Amatola Crescent. The people there know so little about general sanitizing, some do not have the basic bathroom facilities and to top it all, we are in the annual flu season and many are sick as it is, means that we are dealing with an extremely uninformed, difficult situation. We are a third world country and constantly exposed to corruption and lack of all sorts. We are doing out very best.

We want to thank you for your very valuable financial help with our work in Claremont. There is no way we could have done what we have so far without your support. There are only a few left that still gives on a monthly basis and we thank the Lord so much for them. We know these are hard times and we understand that people cannot keep giving to a community they have never seen with their own eyes. Our appreciation is known with God; only He can repay.

If there is any way for another one time investment towards our cause, this would be the right time, since the people in Claremont are in need of so much sanitary products and food. Please remember that this is completely tax-deductible through our 501 (C) 3 we are appealing to you for even the smallest amount. \$1 can go a long way and can

help feed someone – right now we can only look after 289 people but would like to reach out further to help with food, medication etc.

We know that the churches are closing because of the social distancing, you cannot have services, but if you can please request an offering for us, we will appreciate it so very much. We are not released to ask anyone else but you, Pastor Randy. And right now, we are desperate and urged to do so. Please take it to prayer.

Our Nation like many others has been declared a state of emergency. We have had to close our Learning Center (the little school) because social distancing is now a national order. However, Amanda frequents Claremont by preaching, teaching and calling for prayer on a daily basis. She also continually keeps the community informed of the Virus and preventative measures to follow.

Tonight our President declared a 21 day Lock-Down over South-Africa starting on Thursday, which means that we will not be allowed out on the streets unless for emergencies, food supply will be limited etc. The Principal of the Primary School in Claremont phoned us and asked for help because she is concerned that the children will go hungry. We can only do so much and we need help. Desperate times call for desperate measures.

Attached, please find our report for 2018/2019 contributions received from yourself and your congregation. Every Dollar was used to raise a city of refuge where people are now crime free, working in their own community to earn the bread on their tables and no longer living from hand-outs.
